GEORGIA TECH AIDS GUAM WITH ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

ATLANTA, GA....Representatives from Georgia Tech will be in Guam this month to conduct a training program that would help local citizens improve the economy of this small island which is a protectorate of the United States.

Sponsored by the Department of Defense's Office of Economic Adjustment, the program will be conducted for government officials and for private citizens who own businesses in Guam. Included in the training program will be discussions of business development, industrial development and how to stimulate new and additional economic activity.

According to a spokesperson for Georgia Tech, this program is specifically designed to give advice on how to generate new job opportunities for persons affected by the closing down of a U.S. naval ship repair facility on the island.
