POULTRY PLANT SLUDGE DISPOSAL TO BE DISCUSSED AT ONE-DAY SEMINAR

GAINESVILLE, GA.....What to do with wastewater sludge from poultry processing plants is the feature topic of a one-day seminar being held here May 10 by Georgia Tech's Engineering Experiment Station. The seminar is at the Holiday Inn, is free of charge and lasts from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Anyone interested in wastewater treatment and poultry by-product rendering is encouraged to attend the seminar which is being sponsored by the Georgia Department of Agriculture, the Georgia Poultry Federation and the University of Georgia Cooperative Extension Service.

The purpose of the seminar is to familiarize poultry processors and renderers with the problems of waste treatment handling and disposal, and to discuss solutions to these problems. Topics to be covered are sludge treatment; economics of sludge, including treatment, transportation and energy costs; and problems with sludge, including government regulations, on-site disposal and collection and transfer.

Speakers for the seminar will be representatives from the poultry processing and rendering industry as well as wastewater treatment equipment manufacturers.
