ATLANTA, GA....Georgia Tech is helping employers in the Savannah area to meet government health and safety regulations and to remove hazardous conditions from their workplaces.

This service is offered by Georgia Tech's Savannah Area Office free of charge. Consultation is confidential and involves no fines or citations.

The Georgia Tech Occupational Safety and Health Consultation Program began operations a year ago and nearly 300 firms throughout the state have received assistance under its auspices.

The scope of aid provided depends entirely upon plant management's requests. Help may range from assistance with a specific problem to a safety and/or health survey of an entire plant. A special aim of the program is to reach small businesses.
