IN ENGINEERING R & D EXPENDITURES**

A portion of a sentence was inadvertently omitted in our October 1, 1991 news release titled "Georgia Institute of Technology: Tops Among Public Schools in Engineering R & D Expenditures."

The complete third paragraph should read: "Among all U.S. publicly and privately supported institutions, Georgia Tech was third in engineering R & D expenditures, accounting for almost five percent of all engineering R & D conducted at U.S. colleges and universities in 1989. Privately supported Johns Hopkins University and Massachusetts Institute of Technology are ranked first and second overall, with \$648 million and \$287 million in R & D expenditures, respectively."
